NSS Annual Special Camp Report 2019-2020 (9th February 2020 to 15th February 2020)

he NSS unit of Ismail Yusuf College organised seven day camp from 09/02/2020 to 15/02/2020 in Grammanga Ashram School, Aine. Tal – Dahanu, District – Palghar.

34 students participated in this camp. There were 17 girls and 17 boys students. The inauguration of NSS programme was done by Shri. Ramesh Panase on 09/02/2020. The students were divided into different groups to conduct the tasks during the camp. Every day the camp began with National Anthem, Prayer, Exercise and Yoga.

On the second day of the camp students participated in Shramdan by cleaning the premises. All the students actively participated in the creation and development of waste management pit. The sessions were conducted by the faculty members, Dr. Phutane on "Importance of happiness". In the evening there was a session by Mr. GyaneshwarBhosle on "Unity and moral values".

On the third day the students learnt the importance of exercise and the importance of physical fitness. The students actively participated in Yoga sessions and 12 Basic daily exercises which are necessary to maintain physical and mental health. After Yoga session the students participated in the Shramdan at the Aine Village, School. The students visited market area to know about the life of the villagers. In the afternoon session Dr. S.U. Khan explained the students about Nature and Natural Herbs. The students realized the relationship between ecology and Man.

On the fourth day students began their work by cleaning and making kachha road. The students realised the importance of physical labour and the collective effort required for the betterment of the society. The students were showed around the village to observe the functioning of the life in village. The facilities by the

Government were taken into notice like postal system, electricity, water harvesting system, schooling and transportation facilities etc. which was an enriching experience for their holistic development.

On the fifth day of the camp after the camp duties and activities the girls' volunteers took initiative in Pre-Plantation, i.e. filling bags with mud and keeping it ready for nursery plantation. More than 180 bags were filled with mud by girls' volunteers. Boys' volunteers learnt about the different nuances of farming and agriculture. In the afternoon Dr. S.U. Khan conducted the art and sensibility session with the help of experts. The students expressed the various perceptions of Art and its relation to human being. The students learnt about the sensibilities of tribal art. The students were made aware about the folk culture and how it is important to preserve the indigenous culture. The students campaigned about the cleanliness. They interacted with the locals and tried to resolve their issues and problems.

On the sixth day after regular activities students distributed sweets to school students. The students visited the exhibition which was held in the school. In the afternoon students performed street play on Drug Abuse, BetiBachao and BetiPadhao. The aim of NSS was successfully fulfilled.

On the seventh day students visited Aganwadischool and interacted with the school students. The camp was concluded with the personal experiences of the students. Dr. Deshmukh and Professor S. Shanbag guided the students about nation building. The NSS unit of Ismail Yusuf College under the guidance of Hon. Principal, Dr. Swati Wavhal , NSS coordinator Dr. S. U.
