The NSS program at Ismail Yusuf College aims to engage students in various community service initiatives, promoting social responsibility, leadership and personal development.

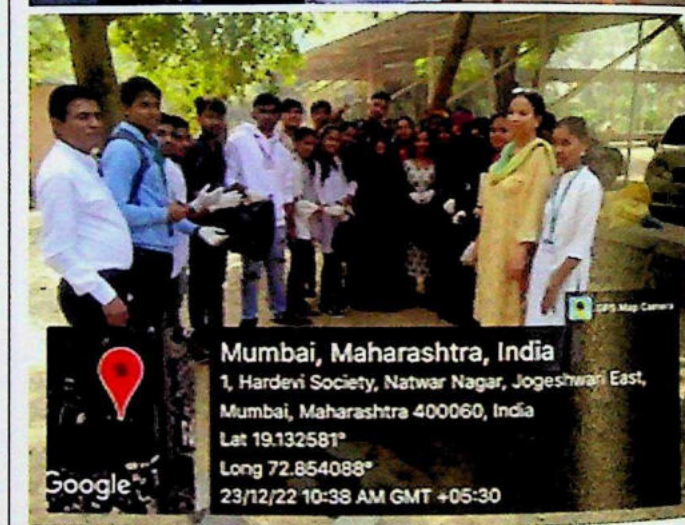
NSS Registration and Volunteer Recruitment: At the beginning of the academic year, an orientation session was organized by Dr. Shahina Khan to familiarize students with the NSS program and its objectives. Following the session, interested students registered as NSS volunteers, forming a dedicated team.

Awareness Campaigns:

Throughout the year, the NSS team organized several awareness campaigns on diverse social issues. The NSS team actively engaged in community outreach initiatives, addressing the needs of marginalized sections of society.

a) Health and Hygiene: Workshops and seminars on Yoga and PolioDrive were conducted on 19th June 2022 to educate the community on preventive measures.

b) Environmental Conservation: On 25th October 2022 Solar Eclisple Observation was done by the



NSS Volunteers. On 19th December 2022 Tree Plantation was carried out in Ismail Yusuf Campus. A Cleanliness Drive was organized on 23rd December 2022 to make the students aware about importance of cleanliness.

- c) **Road Safety:** On Ganapati Visarjan Day the NSS volunteers with the help of traffic police to create awareness about road safety regulations, traffic rules and responsible driving habits among general public.



- d) **Community Outreach Programmes:** On 13th August 2022 a rally was organized for Azadi Mahotstav. The various community outreach initiatives like Blood Donation, Eye Check Up, CBC were undertaken on 20th December and 21st December 2022.



- e) **Skill Development and Recognition of talent:** On 10th August Essay Writing Competition was conducted in order to foster writing skills among the NSS volunteers. On 11th August 2022 Painting Competition was organized in order to inculcate artistic abilities among the NSS volunteers. On 12th August 2022 Rangoli Competition was organized to foster individual talent and art.

Social Initiatives
