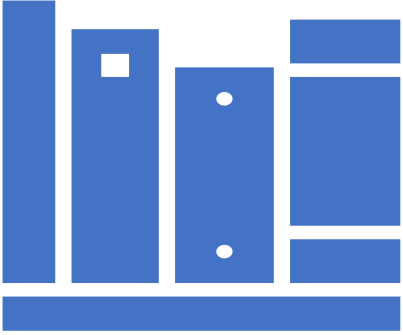

In collaboration with the University of Mumbai, the Govt. of Maharashtra Ismail Yusuf College's Departments of Commerce and Accountancy held an Online International Research Conference on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The platform used for the same was Zoom meetings; a paid subscription was purchased, allowing 100 participants in the conference. The meeting ID was Meeting ID: 832 0228 3998. Our esteemed Principal, Dr. Swati Wavhal, inaugurated the event through the lighting of the lamp at 10.00 am. Following was the flow of events post-inaugural. The conference was led by Prof. Dr. Arvind S Luhar, Mr. Hemraj Bari, Dr. Anjali Alekar and CA Navneet Gokhani. The technical aspect of the conference was looked after by Ms. Shifa Saadan and the entire contractual and visiting faculties. The college received the best wishes from Shri. Chandrakant Dada Patil, the Hon'ble Minister of Higher and Technical Education Govt. of Maharashtra and Dr. Shailendra Deolankar, Director Higher Education, Govt. of Maharashtra. The technical sessions were chaired by 8 experts from across the country. An international keynote speaker from UAE was invited who highlighted the journey of India in Commerce and Management throughout the 75 years of independence. A formal invitation was sent to all. The details of all are mentioned below;


**Post-event details:**

A total of 12 best papers were awarded by selecting 3 awardees in each session, and all the participants were presented with certificates of presentation and participation.

A total of 203 registered for the conference, out of which 122 national papers and 3 international papers were received and after careful scrutiny and following the UGC Guideline of 10% plagiarism, participants were intimated to revise their work and share. Out of the papers received, 85 papers were finally selected for the conference proceedings. With an overwhelming response, the departments are issuing 2 volumes of the conference proceedings with ISBN number 978-93-92975-04-2. UGC CARE Journal Columbo business journal was selected, and 48 papers were sent for further screening and publication. Simultaneously our team is working on other peer-reviewed, CARE and Scopus-indexed journals to ease participants in applying for publication.

Thanking letters were provided to all 8 technical session chairpersons and international keynote speakers. The entire organizing committee was presented with a letter of appreciation for their hard work and dedication.

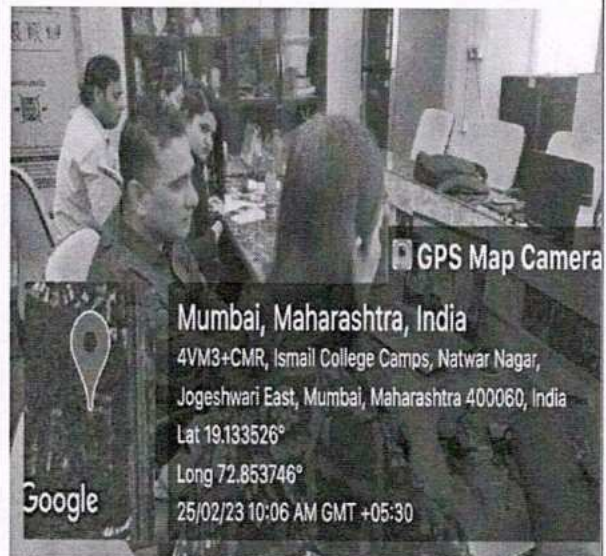
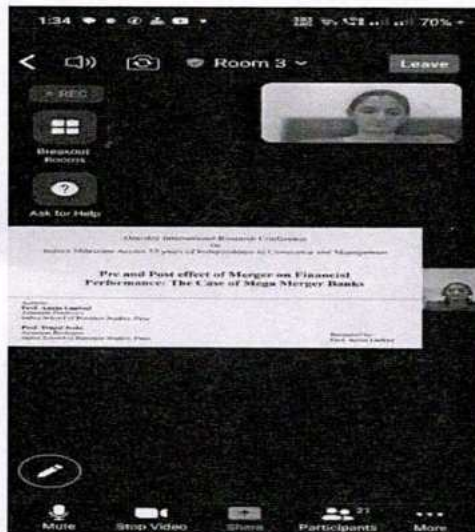

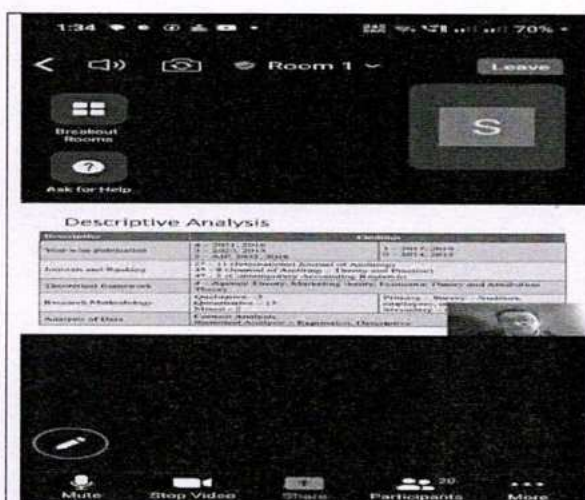
