


EVENTS THROUGHOUT ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024 BY FACULTY OF COMMERCE

Event 1

Distribution of Tab Devices to Link Women Project Batch 2



Seminar on Aspiring Careers in Banking, Accounting, and Taxation



PPT Presentation for FYBAF






On 9th February 2024, the College Auditorium hosted a workshop on Project Work, starting at 09:00 AM. The event was attended by 83 students and 7 faculty members.

Viva Voce for M.Com Part II


